TO: NEWBERRY SPRINGS COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT BOARD OF DIRECTORS FROM: AD-HOC ADVISORY COMMITTEE APPOINTED AT DECEMBER 21, 2004 CSD MEETING

On January 24th the committee met to review the returned surveys sent to 1,162 residents and box holders in Newberry Springs. The surveys solicited community input on how best the CSD might spend \$330,000.00 of discretionary funds received from the Kiewit Pacific Company.

1--As of 5PM on January 24th, 55 survey responses had been received.

- a) 39 responders included their names and addresses or telephone numbers.
- b) 16 responders were anonymous
- c) The top three replies from each responder were tabulated.
- d) 21 responders volunteered to work on a committee to better the community.
- 2-The top two reply categories were <u>road improvements</u> and <u>youth related activities</u> or facilities. 56 replies were in favor of road improvements.
 - a) The road improvements category, included replies favoring a grader and a railroad crossing at Fort Cady Road and I 40.
 - b) The youth related activities or facilites category included replies favoring swimming pool, gym, skate boad facility, youth center, acquiring federal land for recreational purposes, summer youth program and a teen auto center.
 - 23 replies were in favor of youth related activities or facilities.
- 3--No other category received such wide support as the above two items.
 - a) New fast attack fire engine received 11 favorable comments.
 - b) Medical facility received 10 favorable comments.
 - c) Building repairs on Community Center received 7 favorable comments.
 - cc) Library received 7 favorable comments.
 - d) Street lights received 6 favorable comments.
 - e) Security received 6 favorable comments.
 - f) Bus stop shelters received 5 favorable comments.
 - g) All other categories received less than 5 favorable comments.
